

<b>Program Position:</b>	Bar Outreach (10 positions available)
<b>Position Responsibilities:</b>	Primary responsibility will be outreaching bars with safer sex supplies and information.
<b>Skills Required:</b>	HIV/AIDS and Sexual Health. Communication and interpersonal skills and a non-judgmental attitude. Strong and effective communication skills which involves active listening Ability to work with diverse group of people. Outgoing personality. Comfort in atmospheres that serve alcohol.
<b>Training:</b>	Bar Outreach Training. HIV/AIDS 101 and Sexual Health; Harm Reduction; Hepatitis C and Diversity. Workplace Violence and Harassment Prevention Training, Workplace Health and Safety, Ontario Accessibility Standards Training – Serve-Ability. Other as required.
<b>Time Commitment:</b>	Six months. Currently 2-4 hours per month. This will change with increased bar participation.
